We ushered in three new nonprofit partners – Home Again Los Angeles, Guide Dogs of America and Samuel Dixon Family Health Center. Each has done amazing work. With that said, we are very proud to have helped dozens of families find housing, sponsored two Guide Dogs and made a splash with the SDFHC’s Duck Dash. With **312** hours of giving back, via Volunteer Time Off, our employees made a difference. Whether by delivering a Bite of Reality to high school students or helping with event setup for fundraisers, we enjoyed connecting and celebrating our Logix pride. We are looking forward to being present in our market area, working with local charities to elevate our community.

Our annual toy drive benefiting Penny Lane Centers raised **\$3,700** for the nonprofit to purchase gifts for foster care children during the holiday season. An additional 150 toys were donated to the drive, and our Community Stars team visited Penny Lane to deliver the gifts in person. 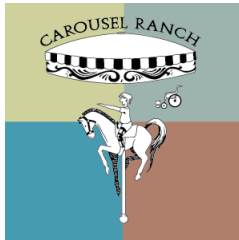

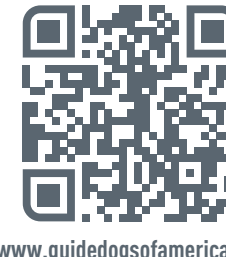

For those without a qualifying medical plan, all service charges are based on the individual's ability to pay, placing a focus for the organization on community fundraising efforts.

Shopping Bag Sale

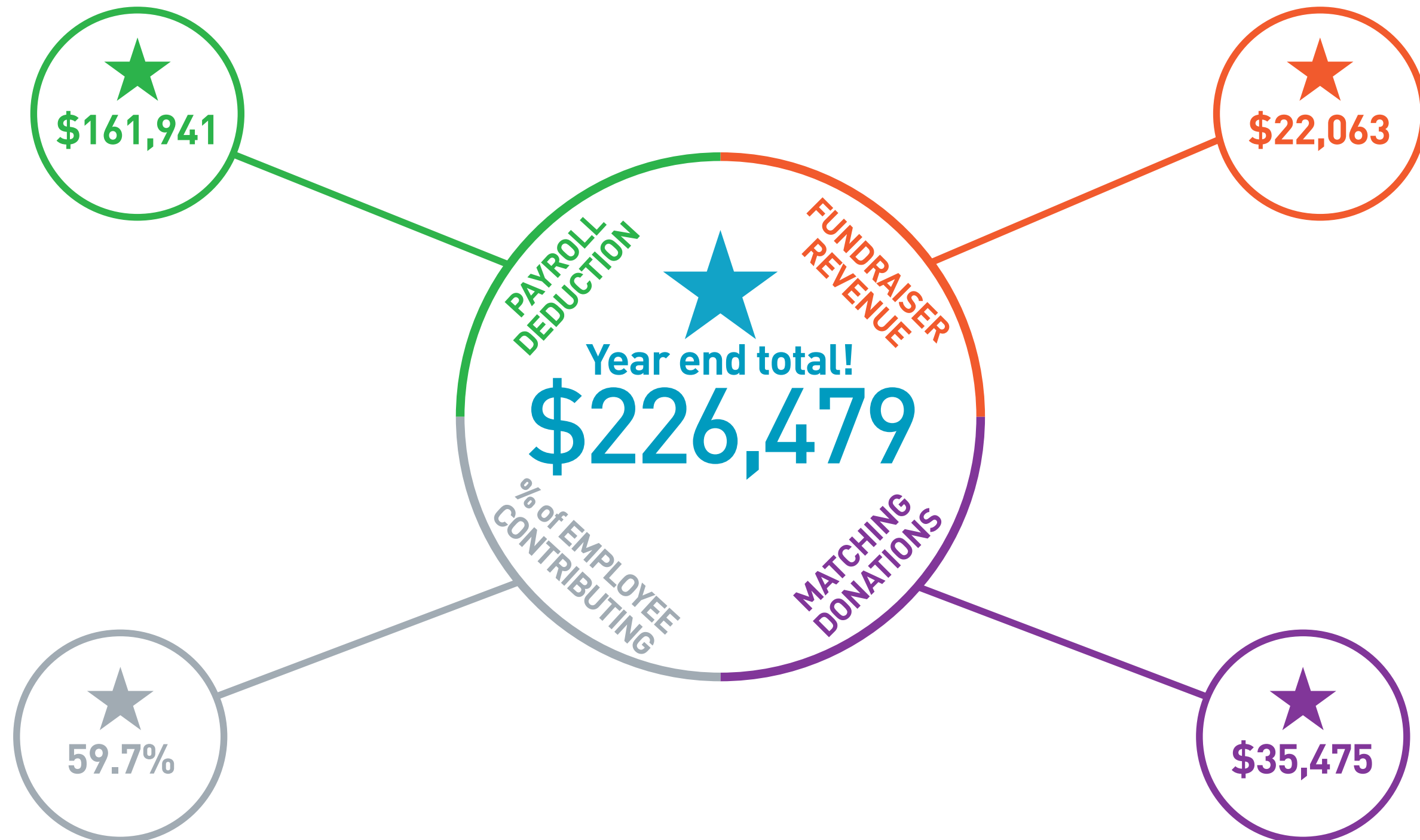
