As Logix Federal Credit Union moves into this next decade, we are doing so with a lot of pride, as our membership continues to grow in the best ways year over year.

You've been telling your family and friends about us, and they continue to open accounts – checking, savings, and more, as well as taking advantage of home, auto loans and credit cards. We truly care about everyone who walks through our doors. And, we care about the communities we serve; that's why we continue to give back through our Logix Community Stars Foundation.

In 2018, we reported that we raised more than \$1 million through the foundation since 2007. In 2019, we're excited to share we've brought in \$179,397 from members, employees and the credit union. The funds that are shared by our staff come from our employee giving program, whereby staff contributes money via payroll deduction, and the credit union provides some matching funds.

We're grateful for our members' participation, as they continue to give via our website, www.custars.org, and in our branches.

We continue to host Volunteer Time Off, through which staff can volunteer up to eight hours per year, with company paid time off. Throughout the year, Logix employees organize these opportunities to support Community Stars' nonprofit partners.

Community Stars distributes all donated funds to local grassroots nonprofits, so the money stays in areas where Logix employees live and work. The credit union and the foundation are dedicated to being good corporate citizens and giving back to the communities we serve.

We're fortunate to work with these charities, based on strong values

that align with ours, and their ability to make a significant difference in the lives of those who need our help. Many thanks to you for your part in making the Logix Community Stars Foundation a success. I look forward to another terrific year for the foundation and the credit union.




employees via payroll deduction

Total amount raised 2019




Donation matching from Logix Federal Credit Union
